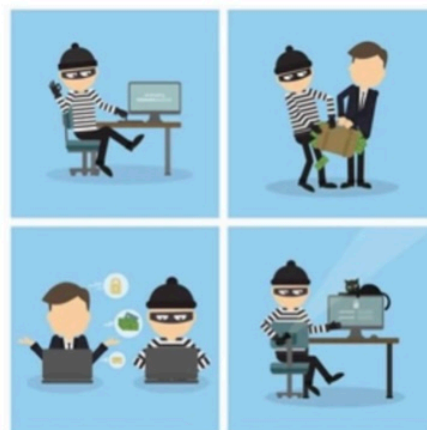
This month
